












Full-Time Staff Headcount


NAJAS 2025 Network Conference

Is Membership Feasible for Us? Worthwhile?

Appropriate? Depends on objectives and culture ...

... but something for most, especially smaller and volunteer, who likely to receive 2-3x return in monetary terms, and more in capacity and intangibles

Requisites

- Status/location, mission/values, primary filters
- No minimum size, no nomenclature required
- Application is simple and acceptance by vote of Members

Once joined

 Annual dues and survey, recognition of membership & partners

Dues levels

- Progressive scale based on revenue
- 6 bands start at \$600 annually
- Unchanged in 12 years
